Amador County Tax Collector Michael E. Ryan is reminding taxpayers that Property Tax Postponement applications are now available through the California State Controller's Office.

California's Property Tax Postponement (PTP) Program, administered by the State Controller's Office, allows homeowners who are seniors, are blind, or have a disability, and who meet income, equity, and other requirements, to postpone payment of property taxes on their primary residence. In the 2017-2018 tax year, California homeowners were able to postpone nearly \$2.9 million in residential property taxes.

Funding for PTP is limited, and applications will be processed in the order they are received beginning October 1. Participants must reapply each year and demonstrate they continue to meet eligibility requirements. A lien will be placed on participating property until the account is paid in full.
